NOTICE OF RACE

5th & 6th June (June 4th - Farr 30s only)

Farr 30	J/105
Beneteau 36.7	J/80
Melges 24	J/30

RULES	The regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in <i>The Racing Rules of Sailing</i> . Each boat must be equipped with a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on channel 77.
ELIGIBILITY	Open to Farr 30s, Beneteau 36.7s, Melges 24s, J 105s, J 80s and J 30s as entries justify. Entries to constitute a class <u>must</u> be received by <u>May 20th, 2010</u> .
ENTRIES	Eligible boats may enter by completing the official Entry Form available at www.cedarpointyc.org and paying all fees, through May 28th. Late entries, which include a \$75 late fee, will be accepted through May 31 st . Entries which include Visa/MasterCard information may be faxed to Jim Brigger at 212-492-3436. Entries with a check or credit card may be mailed to: Jim Brigger, 20 Westview Lane, Norwalk, CT 06854.
ENTRY FEE	The entry fee is \$125 per boat, \$175 for the Farr 30s three day event. Saturday lobster or chicken dinners may be purchased with on-time entries at \$30 each. Reservations limited to the first 125.
INSTRUCTIONS	Sailing Instructions will be available at CPYC after May 28 th . A number of copies may be available from the Race Committee in the starting area. An unofficial copy of the Sailing Instructions will be available on-line at www.cedarpointyc.org after May 28 th .
SCHEDULE	The first warning signal is scheduled for 1100 each day. The number of races will be determined by the race committee. No warning signal will be made after 1500 on Sunday. Social activities include a dinner on the evening of June 5 th and an awards ceremony on June 6 th . For the Farr 30 class only, the first warning signal is scheduled for 1100 on Friday, June 4 th .
RACE AREA	Races will be sailed on Long Island Sound southeast of the mouth of the Saugatuck River.
COURSES	Courses will be windward/leeward, as described in the Sailing Instructions.
PENALTY SYSTEM	For the Farr 30 class only, rule 44.2 is modified to a One-Turn Penalty when not within two lengths of a mark.
SCORING	The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply, except that there will be no throw out unless five races are completed. One race will constitute a regatta. For the Farr 30 class only, there will be no throw out.
PRIZES	Regatta prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries per class.
LOGISTICS	The Club's five ton hoist will be available for launching and hauling competitors and free docking, as available, will be assigned. For reservation, hoist fees and instructions, contact the CPYC at 203-226-7411 no later than May 28.
HOSPITALITY	Light breakfast will be available Saturday and Sunday. Refreshments will be provided at CPYC following each day's racing, including Saturday's dinner and hamburgers & hot dogs on Sunday.
